

BOARD OF MANAGEMENT
MEETING REPORT – 18/11/2014

The Board is reviewing the provision of school uniform items and has established a sub-committee to pursue this.

Our review of school catering and nutrition of meals is underway. A consultant chef is engaged to develop an in-service training course and Form IV had workshops on nutrition given by Alison Kingston.

The enrolment procedure for 2015 is underway and a first round of offer of places has been made.

The Board expressed its congratulations and best wishes to Dr Edward Gash on his appointment as Headmaster of Midleton College.

The chairman thanked the staff, chaplain and principal for the successful organisation of the consecration of the new school chapel and Prize Day ceremony.

A huge range of activities have been going on this term (see weekly bulletins on our website) including successes in various sports, Arts Week, Lá Gaeilge and preparation for the Young Scientist competition.

The Board revised and approved the policy on Admission for implementation in August 2015. The draft will now go to the Board of Directors acting for the patron for ratification.

A School Development Committee will be set up shortly incorporating the various stakeholders. It will act as a steering committee to ascertain the views of pupils, staff, parents and board members regarding whole school development needs.
