Report to the School Community – February 2015

Meeting held on 11th February 2015

The board decided to establish a temporary shop for purchase of uniform and sports kit items normally obtained through the school. It will be co-ordinated with the 'Swap Shop' organised by the Parents Representative Association. The initiative to modernise our school catering is continuing. A tasting opportunity for parents and board members to sample some of the new menus will be held in March. The chairman thanked staff for the many initiatives under way recently including a skiing tour, Spanish tour, Rugby tour and entry to a digital schools project. The board expressed its gratitude to Eli-Lilly Corporation for the gift of 48 reconditioned computers which will be of enormous benefit to the school.

It was decided to increase our enrolment to 120 in Form I next September for one year only due to a very high level of demand. Five class-groups will be formed so that class size is kept low and resources not overstretched.

The board is seeking ideas and volunteers to begin the process of establishing a Past Pupils Association. Please contact the school if you would like to be involved. The board is also planning for Sports Day and Prize Day 2015, and looking ahead to how to mark the 375th anniversary of the founding of the school later this decade.
